My client, Alan L. Hamilton, has been appointed as Independent Executor and has taken the Oath of the Independent Executor of the Estate of his mother, Maurine P. The purpose of this letter is to request, on behalf of my client, your assistance in tracing the estate's assets that have may been deposited and perhaps subsequently withdrawn from your bank.
